

#### 2019 One-year First Destination Survey Results Class of 2017-2018

#### **Background**

- ❖ 1,850 alumni invited to participate.
- ❖ 167 responses; response rate of 9.03%.
- Survey emailed to students who graduated in August 2017, December 2017, and May 2018 with a B.A., B.S., or A.B. Degree.
- ❖ Survey administered on January 31, 2020 using Qualtrics online survey tool.

#### **Current Employment**

- ❖ 61.01% of respondents are currently employed full-time.
- ❖ 7.55% of respondents are employed part-time or have multiple jobs.
- ❖ 39.81% of respondents are employed in the national or international corporations.
- ❖ 41.03% of respondents are working in Tri-county SC.
- ❖ 73.73% of respondents' current annual income range is \$30,000 \$69,999.
- ❖ 38.9% of respondents' employment is highly related to their major.

#### **Employment History**

- 92.3% of respondents were able to find their first full-time position while enrolled as an undergraduate or during the first six months after graduation.
- 58.42% of respondents received 1-2 job offers for full-time employment prior to graduation.

#### **Graduate/Professional School**

- ❖ 23.27% of respondents are attending graduate/professional school full-time or part-time.
- ❖ 22.22% of respondents continuing their education received an assistantship or fellowship.
- ❖ 40.5% of respondents are seeking further education because they believe their career goals can only be obtained through further education.

#### **College of Charleston Undergraduate Experience**

- \* 88.9% of respondents were satisfied or very satisfied with their overall academic experience.
- ❖ 70.1% of respondents would choose the same major field of study again.
- ❖ 88.8% of respondents would choose to attend the College of Charleston again.
- ❖ 54.9% of respondents graduated with no student loans.
