


2022 Undergraduate First Destination Survey

Response Rate

This survey was disseminated to 1858 graduates who were members of the Class of 2020-2021. Out of these 1858 graduates, 234 responded to the survey, giving the survey a Response Rate of 12.6%. Figure 1 (below) illustrates the Response Rate of this survey.
