


2022 Undergraduate First Destination Survey

Response Rate

This survey was disseminated to 2111 graduates who were members of the Class of 2018-2019. Out of these 2111 graduates, 139 responded to the survey, giving the survey a Response Rate of 6.6%. Figure 1 (below) illustrates the Response Rate of this survey.
